WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the Village of South Bend that the property tax request for the current year be the same amount as the property tax request for the prior year.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Village Board of the Village of South Bend, by a majority vote, resolves that:

1. The 2017-2018 property tax request be set at \$7,977.30

2. The budget limit for 2017-2018 is set using the base limitation percent increase of 2.5%.
