The Village Board of Trustees met in regular session June 3, 2026 at 7:00 PM at the Village Hall. Board Members present were: Dale Love, Toby Barnt, Amellia Coffin, Valerie Pike, and Chairperson Pete Klockner and Clerk Deb Cunningham.

The Pledge of Allegiance was said.

A moment of silence was given for remembrance of Past Board Chairperson Brad Graham.

The minutes of the May meeting were read and approved, motion by V. Pike, 2nd by D. Love, Vote all Aye.

The Treasurer's report was read. Bills presented for the Road Fund \$120.02 OPPD (Street Lights). Bills presented for the General Fund \$35.03 OPPD (Town Hall Lights), \$114.00 Wirebuilt (webpage). Cemetery Fund \$450.00 Crimson Lawncare (mowing). Motion by D. Love to transfer \$120.00 from the General Fund to the Road Fund and \$450.00 from General Fund to Cemetery Fund then pay all bills, 2nd by A. Coffin, Vote all Aye.

Building Permits: Deborah Cunningham 104 N Nebraska, new open front porch addition, motion to approve by D. Love, 2nd by A. Coffin, vote all Aye. There are a couple of unpermitted pergolas/porch covers in town that have footings poured, board members P. Klockner and T. Barnt will talk with residents giving them a permit to fill out for approval.
